CLS Group entered into cooperation agreement with China Unicom to develop mobile lottery business

On 19 April 2010, Huacai Yingtong, a subsidiary and the mobile lottery arm of the CLS Group, entered into an agreement with China Unicom for an across-the-board cooperation on the mobile lottery business, covering the telecom operator's 2G WAP, 3G WAP, "Wo" portal as well as mobile news. The agreement has taken the Group's mobile lottery business to the next level, getting in a good position to capture the opportunities brought by the "Three Networks in One" initiative by the Chinese government.

The current China Unicom was formed by the merger of the former China Netcom and the former China Unicom on 6 January 2009, with branch organizations now established in 31 provinces (autonomous regions and municipalities) in China and in several other countries and regions, and is the only telecom company being listed on the stock exchanges of New York, Hong Kong and Shanghai. China Unicom has approximately 150 million mobile phone users including more than 1.8 million 3G users in addition to a well-established WCDMA network and the IPHONE terminal. The cooperation on mobile lottery business takes advantage of the CLS Group's unparalleled technical strength and operational & management capabilities on mobile lottery and information provision as well as its profound understanding of the lottery industry.

On the Group's mobile lottery business, good news keep coming in recent months. The strategic planning, which establishes mobile lottery as one of the Group's three principal businesses, fully reflects the Group's through research and implementation in the business for greater involvement in the business value chain.
